This may be right for you if:

- You want the best possible vision and Dr. Barth agrees that you could be glasses independent.
- The odds of being 20/20 uncorrected are twice as likely.
- **Most patients are not sure what post cataract optical results are ideal for them; the optics can be adjusted three times in order to get you what works best.**
- You value night driving and don't want an implant that might increase halos and glare.

Procedural options:

- RxSight Light Adjustable Lens and the in office UV light delivery device.

Cost and recommendation:

- \$4000 per eye for RxSight Light Adjustable Lens and the in office UV light delivery device.

UPGRADED PACKAGE

Laser Assisted Surgery With Upgraded Lens

This may be right for you if:

- You are comfortable wearing glasses for some activities.
- You want the latest cataract technology to be used during surgery to optimize vision, reduce mild astigmatism, and increase depth of field.

Procedural options:

- LENSAR Femtosecond Laser reduces astigmatism with precise laser incisions and assists in breaking up the cataract segments.

Advanced technology IOL options:

- J & J ext extended depth of field implant is used for both high astigmatism and lower corrections.

Cost and recommendation:

- \$1400 is the cost with a non-spherical lens.
- \$2400 per eye for special order astigmatism implant, if the astigmatism is greater than 1 diopter.

BASIC PACKAGE

Basic Lens Cataract Surgery

This may be right for you if:

- You are comfortable wearing glasses and do not care to reduce your need for them at near and intermediate activities.

Cost and recommendation:

- The basic surgery with Medicare coverage is paid for by most insurances with actual costs dependent on deductible status.
